Team work

- As a mother tongue English language assistant I had to work as part of the English language department team in 3 different schools.
- As part of this team I participated in meetings, had 1-1 sessions with the teachers to plan the course and also did feedback sessions with the teachers after the lessons.
- In the classroom I had to collaborate with the teachers to deliver the lessons (sometimes as a teaching team, other times with the class teacher as a ghost partner).
- Communication is vital for this role: I always try to communicate fully with the teachers (face to face, telephone, whatsapp, email etc)
- Always with my colleagues I always try to get their point of view on an issue before proceeding.

Communication

- As a teacher and linguist communication is vital.
- I try as much as is possible to practice closed loop communication.
- In all my teaching whether with students I always try to communicate fully every action
- In class I always ask the students if they have understood or if further clarification is needed.
- With colleagues I always communicate every single action so we all are in the loop.
- To communicate with private students I have my triangle of communication means: WhatsApp, email and Zoom.
- WhatsApp to organise the lesson and to confirm the day before.
- Email to send the notes of the lesson.
- Zoom to deliver the lesson (all corrections are written in the chat box)

Problem resolution

As a teacher there are often problems to solve. For each problem I:

- Analyse the problem
- Look for possible solutions
- Assess what is the best solution for all involved
- Carry out the solution as quick as possible while constantly communicating with all involved.

*I believe that it is not the problem which is important, but how you react to it.

MANAGEMENT AND LEADERSHIP SKILLS

Management & leadership experience

In my career I have had many management experiences. These include:

- Carrying out the role of youth mentor at oratorio in my home town.
- Managing my own career as a private English teacher.
- Founding and directing an operetta society at University.
- Mentoring students in my halls of residence at University
- Creating and managing courses for the Centro Assistenza Studenti Pavia.
- Founding and directing a small opera society in Milan.

Management & leadership skills

My style of management is based on 3 fundamentals:

1. Leading by doing
2. Communication
3. Delegation

From these 3 fundamentals come the rest. I lead by doing as I never ask my students / mentees / singers / actors to do anything that I can't or won't do myself. Communication, one cannot lead of group of people without a solid system of communication. Delegation, because everyone must be involved in the process and feel part of the team. Also a leader cannot do everything himself.

TEACHING SKILLS OUTSIDE THE MAIN DISCIPLINE

English literature

Reading is one of my hobbies that I like to do at home. I enjoy the works of Agatha Christie, but also Jane Austen and William Shakespeare. Often I have teenage students who need help with literature assignments. When this happens we work on:

- The themes of a work
- The characters of a work
- The setting of a work
- The style of writing
- The reception of said work at the time of publishing.

At school I achieved a grade A* at GCSE in English literature, but because I didn't read for pleasure I didn't fully understand the main literary concepts. It wasn't until I started reading for fun in my early twenties that I really started to understand them, which further encouraged my reading. Whether teaching English as a foreign language or literature I always try to convey to my students a passion for reading, and I use myself as an example.

English for teachers of mathematics & sciences

When the Italian government made it a requirement to teach part of the syllabus in English, I created a specialist intensive course for the teachers required to teach these courses. Over the course of the last 6/7 years I have taught this course to teachers of maths, physics & the sciences. The course involves:

- Teaching the subject specific vocabulary
- Teaching the grammar required to deliver the lessons.
- Helping the teachers to find the optimum way to deliver the lessons in a way that engages the student.

For me the process is always exciting because it is a fantastic way to use the skills I gained at GCSE (I attained grade A for maths, and AA in combined sciences).

English newspapers

For all courses above the level of B1 I incorporate a newspaper section to the course. It is one of my preferred lessons to teach. The newspaper section includes:

- Reading the newspaper article
- The students giving a summary of the article either written or spoken
- A discussion on the main themes of the article
- Other exercises including: role plays based on the article, making predictions based on the content of the article, writing follow up news paper articles etc.

For teaching this is a fantastic way to increase the students' vocabulary but also is always relevant as I always use the most up to date newspaper articles as possible.

English for University professors of Jurisprudence

I have prepared two professors of Jurisprudence to deliver university level classes in English. This demand for courses in English is always increasing so teachers / professors whose skills and experience may not necessarily linguistic are having to hone their linguistics skills. The course I created is non subject specific, it is designed to:

- To increase the teacher's linguistic skills
- To train them to deliver lectures in English with confidence.
- To further their self confidence in this stressful situation (which is usually part of the problem)

This course focuses on:

- Listening skills (from these come all of the rest)
- Grammar: A crash grammar course is carried out to give them the tools to form a phrase and speak in public.
- Topic specific vocabulary

As mentioned these courses are designed to cover all university fields however, Jurisprudence is an interest of mine and I intend to return to University to study Jurisprudence in the next few years. The two professors of Jurisprudence will deliver their first courses in English during the academic year 2021 - 22

English Theatre

In 2018 I designed, taught and directed a theatre course in English. The details of the course are as follows:

- I designed the course from start to finish, from the course presentation to the final performance.
- The course was designed for elementary school children.
- The course was based on and had the theme of European fairy tales.
- At the end of the course the students presented a short 25 minute play.
- I wrote and directed the play which was loosely on the style of British pantomime.
- The course was delivered in English
- The focus of the course was theatrical skills, mindfulness and the process of staging a play.
